# Nebraska Wind Supply Chain Workshop

The Nebraska Department of Economic Development and Manufacturing Extension Partnership, in conjunction with the Nebraska Public Power District and Omaha Public Power District, will host a wind energy supply chain workshop on February 11th, 2010.

Great Lakes WIND Network (GLWN) will facilitate the half-day workshop to inform Nebraska manufacturers of all sizes about the supply chain needs of the wind energy industry. For manufacturers considering this industry, GLWN provides information on:

- New business opportunities in the exploding WIND supply chain market
- Current global trends driving market demand for key components
- The wind supply chain structure and the kinds of components needed
- What original equipment manufacturers look for in their suppliers
- Challenges involved in making the transition to the wind energy supply chain
- Ways to accelerate growth in the wind energy industry
