

NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI)

RE: ACTION REQUIRED – Notice of Intent (NOI) – Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Infrastructure Match Program for 2019 disaster Winter Storm Ulmer (DR-4420) FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Applicants and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) Sub-applicants

Dear PA Applicants and/or HMGP Sub-Applicants:

Many federal programs require local governments to pay a share of the cost of a project, called the **non-federal cost share, local share** and/or **match**. In the aftermath of Winter Storm Ulmer (DR-4420), the match requirements can be burdensome on both Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance (PA) Applicants and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) Sub-applicants.

The State of Nebraska's Department of Economic Development (DED) has allocated \$63,491,100 in CDBG-DR funding to address both the PA and HMGP match through the CDBG-DR Infrastructure Match Program. DED has identified PA Applicants and/or HMGP Sub-applicants with potential eligible project(s) to receive CDBG-DR match funds. This notification constitutes a Notice of Intent (NOI) for the Applicants and Sub-Applicants to submit a Pre-Application(s) for DED to review.

The NOI Pre-Application will open for submissions on **Monday, April 11, 2022**, and will close on **Friday, June 10, 2022; 60 days from the date when submissions open. This NOI package is simply the first step and does not constitute an application or an award.** Please note that this NOI requires action on behalf of the PA Applicant and/or HMGP Sub-applicant. **If it is determined that your organization will not submit the linked Pre-Application, please have the Chief Elected Official sign, date and email the 'Opt Out' letter to DED at ded.cdbgdr@nebraska.gov, advising that the local jurisdiction will not pursue CDBG-DR local match funding for either PA and/or HMGP projects.**

Please follow the below instructions regarding the PA and HMGP Pre-Application Process:

1. **Step 1:** Interested PA and HMGP Applicants/Sub-Applicants should request a secured link from DED via ded.cdbgdr@nebraska.gov to submit a completed PA and/or HMGP Pre-Application.
2. **Step 2:** Please access the PA and/or HMGP Pre-Application attached and fill out in its entirety.
3. **Step 3:** Upload the PA and/or HMGP Pre-Application plus supporting documentation through the secure link provided by DED.

DED will release information about the application process to those deemed eligible following the submission of the Pre-Application.

To support PA Applicants and HMGP Sub-applicants, DED will host a webinar on **Thursday, April 28, 2022**, to walk through the requirements set forth in the linked PA and HMGP Pre-Application.
