<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> For purposes of housing and community development assistance, Targeted Section 3 worker means a Section 3 worker who is: (1) a worker employed by a Section 3 business concern; or (2) a worker who currently fits or when hired fit at least one of the following categories, as documented within the past five years: (i) living within the service area or the neighborhood of the project, as defined in § 75.5; or (ii) a YouthBuild participant.
