	Cor app	businesses organized as a corporation or a partnership, you will need a Nebraska poration Income Tax or Partnership State ID Number to complete the online dication for the Urban Redevelopment Act. You may apply for a state ID number from Department of Revenue online or by filing a NE Tax Application, Form 20.
