Narratives

Disaster Damage:

After record-setting low temperatures that created frost depths approximately two feet deep and ice on rivers and creeks in winter of 2018-2019, Winter Storm Ulmer, a bomb cyclone – or "winter hurricane," a term given to a rapidly intensifying storm – roughly equivalent in power to a Category 2 hurricane, moved across Nebraska between March 12 and 15, 2019. Recorded wind gusts during the cyclone approached 80 mph in many parts of the state and contributed to blinding blizzard conditions that closed highways and stranded motorists. Many roads and bridges, and other infrastructure, were damaged such that they were "out of service" or impassable for a considerable amount of time, causing remarkable disruption.

The bomb cyclone also brought heavy snow, blizzard conditions, rainfall, and above-freezing temperatures into much of the interior of the US. This part of the country already had significant snowpack on the ground due to above-average precipitation during the 2018-2019 winter season. Nebraska experienced its worst flooding event in 50 years between March and July 2019. As temperatures warmed in April and May 2019, the heavy snow and excessive rainfall from the 2018-2019 winter season contributed to rapid melting of ice and snow, resulting in flooded rivers and ice jams that breached levees, damaged infrastructure, and destroyed thousands of homes and businesses. The eastern side of the state was particularly impacted by flooding, resulting in fatalities, evacuations, and search and rescue missions.

In many areas, the flood damage was exacerbated by thick river ice breaking off in an atypically severe manner. Bridges were washed away by flooding or rendered impassable due to accumulated ice chunks.

Recovery Needs:

Grantees who receive an allocation through the CDBG-DR program are required to conduct an Unmet Needs Assessment (UNA) to assist in the identification and prioritization of critical unmet needs following a disaster and to identify long-term recovery efforts that will mitigate against future disasters. For DR-4420, the State of Nebraska's UNA, as carried out and completed for the Initial Action Plan, identified \$269,043,934 in unmet need, specifically \$55,637,821 in unmet housing need, \$196,163,422 in unmet infrastructure need, and \$17,242,691 in economic revitalization need. Throughout the State, recovery efforts have been taken and continue to be initiated for public and private housing and infrastructure facilities. During the development of the Initial Action Plan, local jurisdictions reported having completed repairs on homes that were damaged or destroyed as well as repairing infrastructure facilities. However, additional need remains.

As a result of the UNA process, Nebraska plans to establish the following programs (funding opportunities) to assist in its disaster recovery:

- 1. Infrastructure Match Program
- Affordable Housing Construction Program 2.
- Homeowner Assistance Program 3. 4.
- Risk Awareness Planning Program
- 5. Housing Resilience Planning Program

Nebraska's CDBG-DR program and funding opportunities are not designed or intended to create Program Income (PI) nor establish revolving loan funds (RLFs).

Low- and Moderate-Income (LMI) and Vulnerable Populations. Nebraska will prioritize activities under the housing programs that benefit LMI households, persons experiencing homelessness, and individuals requiring supportive housing, as identified in 24 CFR 91.315(e).

Prioritization of vulnerable populations aligns with applicable Fair Housing requirements.

<u>Most Impacted and Distressed (MID) Areas</u>. HUD requires that 80% of CDBG-DR funds be allocated and spent in HUD-defined MID areas. HUD originally identified the MID areas as being the entirety of Sarpy County, zip code 68025 (Fremont, Inglewood, and Woodcliff) in Dodge County, and zip codes 68064 and 68069 in Douglas County (Valley and Leshara). Based on the UNA, Nebraska expanded the HUD-defined MID to include all of Dodge County and Douglas County. As a result, Dodge, Douglas, and Sarpy counties will be the target for 80% of available CDBG-DR funding.

Infrastructure Needs: As the Initial Action Plan UNA and HUD's early assessments both indicated, DR-4420 generated catastrophic impacts to infrastructure, resulting in significantly higher losses in that core category than economic and housing needs. Infrastructure damage was widespread, with 84 out of 93 counties and four tribal areas impacted, reporting damage to roads, bridges, levees, dams and many other critical infrastructure facilities. To address the extensive infrastructure needs within the state, the state is prioritizing CDBG-DR funding under DR-4420 for infrastructure recovery. However, following the launch of the Infrastructure Match Program, designed to support local jurisdictions by making available CDBG-DR funding to pay the requisite local cost-share towards FEMA Public Assistance (PA) and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, the actual amount requested by applicants was significantly less than anticipated. While there were over 300 applications for funding, nearly one-third were ineligible and over 80 percent of those projects determined initially eligible for DR funding were for amounts less than \$50,000.

Housing Needs: To determine how many housing units would require funding through the CDBG-DR program, DED conducted a data analysis to review the total number of homes served through existing State housing programs. DED estimated the total remaining unmet need in both the HUD MID and state MID areas to be 252 housing units. Upon the launch of the Affordable Housing Construction Program, the interest in funding to support construction of housing exceeded expectations. Thus, DED reallocated costs from undersubscribed programs to support that demand.

Overall Progress Narrative:

Progress Overview QPR-2023 Q3, July 1, 2023 - September 30, 2023

During this reporting period, DED selected its first award in support of new construction of affordable, owner-occupied, single-family housing; conducted detailed eligibility review for hundreds of infrastructure projects seeking CDBG-DR to support their local cost-share requirements; and carried out strategic planning, including an assessment of remaining unmet needs ahead of proposing a substantial action plan amendment (APA3). DED plans to submit APA3 in 2023 Q4, following the end of the 30-day public comment period. As proposed, APA3 addresses the shifting unmet needs based on the completion of multiple application cycles, funding decisions under the infrastructure and housing programs, and ongoing outreach and engagement with local, state and regional partners, and stakeholders to assess outstanding unmet recovery needs. APA3 constitutes a substantial amendment because it proposes the reallocation of over \$5M in funding and a change in benefit. DED follows the amendment process as detailed in its HUD-approved Action Plan.

The interest in funding for affordable housing construction activities continues to be high. While steadily moving awarded projects ahead under its existing infrastructure and housing programs, DED continues to assess programs and their allocations, and identify additional areas of need in the core sectors of housing, infrastructure, and planning.

Housing. DED processed two (2) payment requests for awards made under the Affordable Housing Construction Program (AHCP)--LIHTC Gap Financing subprogram, one (1) of which was still in process at the end of the reporting period. Out of ten (10) submitted applications, DED selected one (1) application for funding under the Affordable Housing Construction Program (AHCP)--Homeownership Production (HPP). Outreach and informational sessions were part of the application cycle. However, in the scoring process and as mentioned in 2023 Q2, DED identified a need to conduct additional technical assistance to support HPP applicants that did not meet threshold for an award. Following the announcement of the award, DED provided TA on a one-on-one basis, and anticipates additional awards in 2023 Q4. The HPP award, which is for the new construction of eight (8) single-family homes in Douglas County, will be added in DRGR once the funding agreement is in place; this is anticipated in 2023 Q4. Meanwhile, the DR Housing Program Manager continues oversight of the development of program materials to support AHCP--Small Rental, inclusive of application guidelines, scoring matrix, and outreach and presentation materials; DED anticipates opening applications in 2023 Q4.

<u>Infrastructure</u>. All HGMP and several PA projects are ongoing. DED is in the process of determining next steps for reimbursement, reporting on accomplishments, and the like. In 2023 Q3, DED entered into SRA agreements for twelve (12) HMGP projects; this represents all known HMGP projects seeking CDBG-DR for match funds. Based on activity progress underway, DED expects to process its first payment requests for infrastructure activities in 2023 Q4, representing 26 projects (2P and 24 PA). In accordance with the program guide, all costs charged to CDBG-DR are for reimbursement.

<u>Technical Assistance</u>. To support successful implementation of its programs, DED continues to expand and refine its toolkit materials containing technical assistance for potential subrecipients and successful applicants through webinars, program tools, and other resources. DED publishes these materials on its public website.

During this period, DED held or participated in several one-on-one technical assistance sessions, including monthly meetings with subrecipients managing HGMP projects and an on-site visit to support Loup Public Power District PA projects underway; five (5) project coordination and progress meetings with NEMA; and numerous ad hoc phone calls and emails were conducted to support Match Program participants. In direct support of housing activities: five (5) TA webinars were held for HPP applicants, including two (2) one-on-one sessions, and several other one-on-one meetings were carried out in support of awards made for multifamily housing. To get to funding agreement, DED established weekly meetings for housing awardees. Additionally, informal discussions and conversations are ongoing with potential and awarded project partners, advocacy groups, housing developers, and infrastructure subrecipients. This includes ongoing discussions with the Village of Winslow regarding relocation.

<u>Expenditures and Accomplishments</u>. Consistent with the data included in the Grantee Projections dashboard, DED had anticipated incurring and did incur costs for planning and admin and housing activities during Q3 2023. However, there were no expenditures nor accomplishments to report during this period for infrastructure. While housing activities have begun to draw down funds, accomplishments are not recorded until after construction is complete. Construction is underway for two (2) housing activities. With all known HMGP SRAs now in place, Match projects are expected to begin drawing down in 2023 Q4. As DED expects to make available CDBG-DR funding in the DED-NIFA joint application process through the 2025 QAP, due diligence to enter those funding agreements is ongoing. Construction season is short, however.

<u>Challenges and Lessons Learned</u>. As stated in prior reporting periods, aligning program launch timelines with capacity continues to be a challenge. Additionally, short construction seasons will be a challenge throughout. The story of the Infrastructure Match Program continues to unfold as DED gears up to begin processing payment requests. Due to the timing of CDBG-DR funding, many of the PA projects had no intention of applying for HUD funding at the time of FEMA project creation. FEMA does not identify the same performance measures for their reporting requirements. For example, FEMA tracks metric tons of gravel or aggregate while HUD requests for linear miles or feet of public improvement for roads/bridges. The difference in reporting measures makes reporting in DRGR difficult specifically for projects that were completed prior to 2021. DED has identified 24 PA projects to be funded in Q4, the challenge will now be packaging the PA projects into their respective DRGR activity to provide accurate performance measure reporting.

<u>Planned Progress</u>. During 2023 Q4, DED will continue to carry out a strategic planning and public participation process as part of a substantial action plan amendment, which represents the third amendment (APA3) to its action plan. The APA3 Public Comment Period is scheduled for October 16 to November 15; a public hearing is scheduled for November 1. DED



intends to formalize its relationship with the University of Nebraska-Lincoln for carrying out certain planning activities related to Risk Awareness and Resiliency.

A webinar to support the upcoming application cycle for AHCP-Small Rental is scheduled for November 16. During 2023 Q4, DED anticipates processing additional payments to reimburse subrecipients and awardees (e.g., housing developers) for costs incurred; this includes infrastructure and housing activities currently represented in the DRGR Action Plan.

August 3, 2023. Affordable Housing Construction Program--Homeownership Production subprogram (AHCP-HPP): DED held three (3) TA sessions for applicants.

August 17, 2023. AHCP: Conducted direct outreach with Housing Foundation of Sarpy County on their need for and scope of affordable housing construction.

August 28, 2023. Affordable Housing Construction Program--LIHTC Gap Financing subprogram (AHCP-LIHTC): Closed on funding agreement on Highlander Phase V. (Details to be incorporated in the DRGR Action Plan in Q4.)

September 6, 2023. DED published the HUD-approved QPR for 2023 Q2.

September 13, 2023. AHCP-HPP: Held two (2) one-on-one TA meetings with non-select applicants. (Revisions are due by applicants mid-November.)

September 21, 2023. Match: DED delivered on-site TA to Loup Public Power District in connection to their PA projects seeking CDBG-DR for local match.

Activity Description:

This activity is to cover the state administrative cost of running the CDBG-DR Program, specifically the infrastructure, housing, and planning programs in Nebraska to provide assistance to Nebraska communities recovering from Winter Storm Ulmer (DR-4420). The state administrative costs will not exceed five percent (5%) of the total allocation. DED anticipates retaining the full 5% allocated for administrative costs associated with the CDBG-DR for purposes of oversight, management, and reporting. Any necessary changes will be reflected in Action Plan amendments.

Location Description:

Activity Progress Narrative:

Refer to the Overall Progress Narrative for a summary of administration-related efforts carried out in Q3 in relationship to and in support of program and activity delivery. What follows is a more detailed account of administrative actions, particularly as it relates to DRGR.

<u>DRGR Action Plan</u>. DED set up additional DRGR activities in response to funding decisions made under its programs. For infrastructure, DED set up several DRGR activities in response to funding decisions involving FEMA Public Assistance (PA) projects via the Infrastructure Match (Match) Program. Although over 200 PA projects were identified for funding, DED's Infrastructure Match Program Manager conducted an analysis of those projects, distilling them into 20 activities categorized by activity type, National Objective, and geographical location. This outcome was informed by HUD TA and is aimed at streamlining DRGR reporting.





Modifications to DRGR activities is ongoing as projects are carried out. In this quarter, some modifications were made to infrastructure activities and typo corrections to two housing activities. While those changes were made in Q3, DED submitted, and HUD approved those changes in DRGR following the end of the quarter. DED appreciates HUD's actions to help ensure this QPR would not be delayed.

<u>Planned Progress</u>. In 2023 Q4, DED intends to submit APA3, a substantial amendment, to HUD on November 22; APA3 is anticipated to be in effect by no later than January 6, 2024. Upon HUD's approval, DED will make the necessary changes to the DRGR Action Plan required by APA3. In accordance with its policies and procedures, upon HUD's action, DED will also publish, on its website, the public-facing action plan, as amended and approved by HUD, and associated materials. Proposed changes in APA3 will also require DED to update program materials including its program guides.

Continuing the process initiated during 2023 Q2, DED will continue entering activities into its DRGR Action Plan to reflect funding decisions made to-date. To support DED, HUD has set up a TA session with a DRGR Specialist; this is scheduled for November 20.

Beginning 2023 Q4 or 2024 Q1, DED anticipates submitting DRGR voucher corrections to move costs to-date charged to (1) Admin that are eligible and allocable under Activity Delivery Costs and (2) Admin that are eligible and allocable under Planning Costs.
