Narratives

Disaster Damage:

After record-setting low temperatures that created frost depths approximately two feet deep and ice on rivers and creeks in winter of 2018-2019, Winter Storm Ulmer, a bomb cyclone – or "winter hurricane," a term given to a rapidly intensifying storm – roughly equivalent in power to a Category 2 hurricane, moved across Nebraska between March 12 and 15, 2019. Recorded wind gusts during the cyclone approached 80 mph in many parts of the state and contributed to blinding blizzard conditions that closed highways and stranded motorists. Many roads and bridges, and other infrastructure, were damaged such that they were "out of service" or impassable for a considerable amount of time, causing remarkable disruption.

The bomb cyclone also brought heavy snow, blizzard conditions, rainfall, and above-freezing temperatures into much of the interior of the US. This part of the country already had significant snowpack on the ground due to above-average precipitation during the 2018-2019 winter season. Nebraska experienced its worst flooding event in 50 years between March and July 2019. As temperatures warmed in April and May 2019, the heavy snow and excessive rainfall from the 2018-2019 winter season contributed to rapid melting of ice and snow, resulting in flooded rivers and ice jams that breached levees, damaged infrastructure, and destroyed thousands of homes and businesses. The eastern side of the state was particularly impacted by flooding, resulting in fatalities, evacuations, and search and rescue missions.

In many areas, the flood damage was exacerbated by thick river ice breaking off in an atypically severe manner. Bridges were washed away by flooding or rendered impassable due to accumulated ice chunks.

Recovery Needs:

Grantees who receive an allocation through the CDBG-DR program are required to conduct an Unmet Needs Assessment (UNA) to assist in the identification and prioritization of critical unmet needs following a disaster and to identify long-term recovery efforts that will mitigate against future disasters. For DR-4420, the State of Nebraska's UNA, as carried out and completed for the Initial Action Plan, identified \$269,043,934 in unmet need, specifically \$55,637,821 in unmet housing need, \$196,163,422 in unmet infrastructure need, and \$17,242,691 in economic revitalization need. Throughout the State, recovery efforts have been taken and continue to be initiated for public and private housing and infrastructure facilities. During the development of the Initial Action Plan, local jurisdictions reported having completed repairs on homes that were damaged or destroyed as well as repairing infrastructure facilities. However, additional need remains.

As a result of the UNA process, Nebraska plans to establish the following programs (funding opportunities) to assist in its disaster recovery:

- 1. Infrastructure Match Program
- Affordable Housing Construction Program
- Homeowner Assistance Program
- Risk Awareness Planning Program
- Housing Resilience Planning Program

Nebraska's CDBG-DR program and funding opportunities are not designed or intended to create Program Income (PI) nor establish revolving loan funds (RLFs).



<u>Low- and Moderate-Income (LMI) and Vulnerable Populations</u>. Nebraska will prioritize activities under the housing programs that benefit LMI households, persons experiencing homelessness, and individuals requiring supportive housing, as identified in 24 CFR 91.315(e).

Prioritization of vulnerable populations aligns with applicable Fair Housing requirements.

Most Impacted and Distressed (MID) Areas. HUD requires that 80% of CDBG-DR funds be allocated and spent in HUD-defined MID areas. HUD originally identified the MID areas as being the entirety of Sarpy County, zip code 68025 (Fremont, Inglewood, and Woodcliff) in Dodge County, and zip codes 68064 and 68069 in Douglas County (Valley and Leshara). Based on the UNA, Nebraska expanded the HUD-defined MID to include all of Dodge County and Douglas County. As a result, Dodge, Douglas, and Sarpy counties will be the target for 80% of available CDBG-DR funding.

Infrastructure Needs: As the Initial Action Plan UNA and HUD's early assessments both indicated, DR-4420 generated catastrophic impacts to infrastructure, resulting in significantly higher losses in that core category than economic and housing needs. Infrastructure damage was widespread, with 84 out of 93 counties and four tribal areas impacted, reporting damage to roads, bridges, levees, dams and many other critical infrastructure facilities. To address the extensive infrastructure needs within the state, the state is prioritizing CDBG-DR funding under DR-4420 for infrastructure recovery. However, following the launch of the Infrastructure Match Program, designed to support local jurisdictions by making available CDBG-DR funding to pay the requisite local cost-share towards FEMA Public Assistance (PA) and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, the actual amount requested by applicants was significantly less than anticipated. While there were over 300 applications for funding, nearly one-third were ineligible and over 80 percent of those projects determined initially eligible for DR funding were for amounts less than \$50,000.

Housing Needs: To determine how many housing units would require funding through the CDBG-DR program, DED conducted a data analysis to review the total number of homes served through existing State housing programs. DED estimated the total remaining unmet need in both the HUD MID and state MID areas to be 252 housing units. Upon the launch of the Affordable Housing Construction Program, the interest in funding to support construction of housing exceeded expectations. Thus, DED reallocated costs from undersubscribed programs to support that demand.

Overall Progress Narrative:

Progress Overview QPR-2023 Q4, September 30 â¿¿ December 31, 2023

DED submitted its third action plan amendment (APA3) to HUD for approval on November 17. Submission followed the requisite 30-day public comment period for a substantial amendment. Consistent with the Citizen Participation Plan (CPP), APA3 is considered substantial because it includes a change in benefit and reallocates more than \$5 million. All public comments are recorded in the APA3 Summary of Changes document, a companion document to action plan amendments. HUDâ¿s approval is anticipated by January 2, 2024. Once HUD approves APA3, the State will be able implement the proposed changes in 2024, including any necessary updates to policies and procedures.

Other planning activities are ongoing. As planned, DED entered a contract with the University of Nebraska-Lincoln for planning activities supportive of Risk Awareness and Housing Resiliency. DED and UNL established a work plan prior to the end of the quarter. Targeted to subrecipients in the HUD-MID, DED has not yet opened applications for Housing Resiliency Planning projects. This is anticipated to occur in 2024 Q1 or Q2.

Infrastructure. While several projects have requested, been approved for payment, and paid DR funds in this quarter, Infrastructure Match Program PA and HMGP projects continue to be reviewed for eligibility. The drawdowns in Q4 are from the initial set of awards having occurred in May 2023. As a reminder, all PA project awards are combined into a single SRA with NEMA and DR payments are designed to be reimbursement; and of those PA projects, nineteen (19) received their DR portion in this quarter. DEDâ¿¿s Compliance Team, in coordination with the DR Manager, began the initial stages of monitoring NEMA.

In 2024, budget amendments are anticipated for at least one (1) HMGP project due to cost overruns and at least two (2) more rounds of awards are anticipated for PA or HGMP projects. Given the Match program is a new funding opportunity resulting from the DR allocation, some launch-related challenges were expected. The anticipated additional funding rounds are a direct result of additional, targeted outreach and engagement efforts by the program manager to the local jurisdictions. Already, at least three (3) HMGP projects are set to receive a NOIA in 2024 Q1. The Match projectâ¿s experiencing overruns will be carefully reviewed in coordination with NEMA. Discussions of the use of ADCs are ongoing with subrecipients. DED continues to track those costs internally.

Housing. The first application selected for the Affordabl Housin Construction Program (AHCP) â¿¿ Homeownership Production Program (HPP) has not yet achieved funding agreement; however, progress continues on due diligence items including the ERR; and we plan to add the DRGR activity on or around Environmental Clearance.

Following the program manager $\hat{a}\lambda$ direct outreach to applicants not initially selected, DED received seven (7) revised AHCP-HPP applications. Review is ongoing and awards are anticipated in 2024 Q1.

Awarded under AHCP-LIHTC, DED entered a funding agreement for Cardinal Commons I on November 10 and attended the groundbreaking on November 30.

Application cycles are ongoing for AHCP-LIHTC and in alignment with NIFAâ¿¿s QAP via a joint application process. Out of a total of eleven (11) applications, five (5) applications for AHCP-LIHTC under the 2024 QAP cycle were received and reviewed in this quarter. Applicant corrections of any deficiencies are due in 2024 Q1 2024 and awards are anticipated in 2024 Q2.

While DED held an application technical assistance webinar on November 16, the launch of the AHCP-Small Rental application was delayed allowing focus on the resubmission of HPP applications. Launch is rescheduled for 2024 Q1.

The regular technical assistance check-ins with developers have proved successful and continue to be scheduled to support projects during the initial award and due diligence phases.

Planned progress.

DED is in the process of updating its program materials (e.g., program guides, marketing, technical assistance); as appropriate, these revisions will be published to the public DR website following HUDâ¿¿s approval of APA3. DED will also revise vouchers to reallocate ADCs and planning costs initially charged against Admin to the appropriate DRGR activity.



<u>Infrastructure</u>: additional awards for PA and HMGP projects are anticipated in 2024. DED is also considering other infrastructure projects in the HUD-MID area for award. Monitoring is underway for PA projects.

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<u>Housing</u>: additional awards for AHCP are anticipated in 2024 under LIHTC, HPP, and Small Rental. Following the approval of APA3, DED is in the process of updating its program materials acknowledging the removal of the standalone non-construction housing program, Homeowner Assistance Program (HAP). Monitoring is planned for AHCP-LIHTC projects in process.

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<u>Planning</u>: applications will be opened for Housing Resiliency Planning; DED anticipates awards will be implemented via subrecipient agreements with eligible local jurisdictions. In partnership with UNL, stakeholder meetings will be scheduled for Risk Awareness and Housing Resiliency Planning. For this exempt activity, DED will submit and take the appropriate actions in HEROS in 2024 Q1.

In Q4 2023, the Dodge County Gauge Monitoring project closed with FEMA. The project's scope included the purchase and installation of a monitoring system that will provide early flood warning for the benefit area. Dodge County received 9,720.00 in CDBG-DR funding to cover the 25% local share.
