



Self-Verification of Refugee Status

The US Law 8 USC § 1101(a)(42) defines a refugee as an individual located outside of the United States, is of special humanitarian concern to the United States, is unable or unwilling to return to their native country because of persecution or fear due to race, religion, nationality, political opinion or membership in a particular social group, is not resettled in another country, and is admissible to the United States.

A refugee does not include anyone who ordered, incited, assisted, or otherwise participated in the persecution of any person on account of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion.

Please check the box below if you are self-verifying as a refugee:

- I am a refugee in the United States who resides in Nebraska.

Provide a copy of one of the following supporting documents supporting refugee status:

- Form I-94 (Arrival-Departure Record noting that the individual has been admitted under 207 of the INA)
- Form I-766 (Employment Authorization Document with code A03)
- I-730 Approval Letter
- Visa 93 or V-93 on the I-94
- Form I-551 (green card)
